



This guide provides guidance for users to install and configure NetMotion clients on Windows systems.

Installation:


Follow the steps below to install Netmotion software and drivers.

1. Download to the system the appropriate mobility client at <http://connect.miamidade.gov/> -> Netmotion, (example, version 10.1 on a Windows 7 64 bit system: Mobility_xg_client_10.10_Win7_x64_release.exe).
2. Run the executable and respond to the prompts accordingly, (see screen dumps below).






3. Allow the installation to proceed:




4. Click install to install the device driver:



5. Allow completion of installation and click "Finish"



6. Click “Yes” Reboot




7. Upon reboot, during Windows logon, you may get the logon prompt. You can skip this to not log on at this time if you wish.
